# From the Editor's Desk...



Recently, I read an article about a survey of the British population, which concluded that 19% of the population claimed to attend church at least once a month, and, if you add up, and average out, what people claim, 15% of the British population would be in church every Sunday. But the last national church census, when it is actually counted who really is in church, reveals that only 7% of the population are actually attending worship in church on any given Sunday. Only half of the people who say they go to church are actually in church!

Considerable numbers of people think going to church is a good thing. They claim to attend liturgical services more often than they really do. They are not ashamed to make this claim, it's important to them. They overestimate their attendance record. They believe that they are in church more often than they really are.

But the reality is that despite good intentions to attend liturgical services, the pressures of everyday life are keeping people away from worship. People are not attending as often as they intend. Things come up which people choose to use as a reason not to attend Church services. This phenomenon has most affect on those who come to church least frequently in the first place; for if you miss Sunday service more often than not, what does it matter if you miss a few more? If sharing in liturgical worship is just one thing you will consider amidst a host of other things that you could also be doing on a Sunday, then it gets crowded out. If the decision whether-or-not to attend worship is always taken anew each and every Sunday, then it can become a burden to keep on making that choice. Statistics tell us that this is a serious problem for today, but it is not a new problem! The writer of the book of Hebrews, over 2000 years ago, offers timeless advice: 'Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another.' (Hebrews 10:25) Liturgical worship, among other things, ought to be an encouraging experience, and we all need encouragement.

The alternative to making your mind up afresh about each Sunday is to have already decided that attending services at church each Sunday is a priority. If you *'Keep Sunday Special'* (to use the words of the old campaign), and always set aside Sunday for worship and rest, then your decision will have always been made for you, you will know where you are going on Sunday morning — to Church! If you think that going to church is important, if you believe that attending worship in fellowship with others is a good thing, then make it a priority.


Do you use a diary? What have you written in for Sunday mornings or evenings? If you think sharing in prayer worship at church is important then why not fill in every Sunday for the rest of the year? If anyone asks you what you are doing on Sunday tell them that you are going to church, tell them that you are free after noon.

When were you last in church? Is it honestly longer ago than you are proud of? Are you letting bad habits spoil good intentions? Please be assured, there is always a welcome and non-judgmental place for you in our Holy Ukrainian Orthodox Church.

One person wrote: "It was the Sobor I have waited for all my life — Christ centered and Spirit filled." Another wrote: "The Sobor was witness to the presence of the Holy Spirit, vivifying, inspiring, embracing, clarifying, healing..." Still another: "I met so many gifted and devoted people who are ready to offer their services to God through our Holy Church." Another:

"I actually feel that I am now part of a spontaneously created network of faithful people who fully comprehend that they have a ministry to fulfill." And finally: "The Sobor committee meetings that I attended were so informative and comforting to me and my concerns about lack of leadership in our parishes were, for the most part, dispelled."

Such are the comments received by various members and staff of the Consistory since the close of the Sobor that virtually all its participants did not want to end. This triennial event in the life of our Holy Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the USA — the gathering of faithful

Following brunch the clergy and lay delegate, alternate and guest participants of the Sobor gathered in the rotunda and library of the Consistory building to prepare for the procession into the Sobor meeting room in the Ukrainian Cultural Center. The people of God entered the Center carrying the sacred icon of the Pochaiv Mother of God and singing the traditional processional hymn, "O Lord, save Your people," and bless Your inheritance..." and the work assigned by God to those gathered began. During his "State of the Church" remarks, His Beatitude defined the Sobor theme

to which that Light has illumined every aspect of our Church's life over the preceding three years. As a shepherd of souls, His Beatitude led the clergy and lay delegates on a journey, which clearly pointed out the manifestations of that Light from the first moment of creation and the proclamation "Let there be light!" to the Light of Christ, which burst forth in all its brilliance from the tomb, transformed by the Risen Christ.

His Beatitude then pointed to manifestations of the Light of Christ in the contemporary life of our Holy Church, singling out All Saints Camp, Emlenton, Pa., the care provided the Christ's little ones - the orphans in Ukraine by our Church through its mission teams, the establishment and growth of mission parishes in this country the presence in our parishes of laity and clergy,

whose faith is one of quality, the light of Christ penetrating our Holy Church's priestly vocation program, guiding 5 candidates from Ukraine's Ivano-Frankivsk Eparchy and 9 from the USA through the portals of

Saint Sophia (Holy Wisdom) Seminary to be lovingly nurtured in the Holy Mysteries and pastoral service.

Throughout his address, His Beatitude hearkened back to the morning's inaugural Divine Liturgy, to awesome and sacred moment of calling down the Holy Spirit to transform each and every one of us so that our thoughts and actions might always conform to Christ. As an instrument of the Good Shepherd, His Beatitude as Metropolitan and Primate of the Church, noted the Lord of the Harvest's loving solicitude for the Holy Ukrainian Orthodox Church, which He entrusts to our care by providing for future priests and bishops, men of high spiritual credential, men of faith, who will shepherd the Church long after the present priests and bishops have entered into the joy of their Master.

Having said this, His Beatitude spoke of the Metropolitan's obligation before God to ensure that the ranks of the Episcopacy are filled and presented as candidate for the holy office of Bishop, the venerable Archimandrite Daniel [Zelinskyy]. The Sobor body immediately arose and declared "AXIOS! AXIOS! AXIOS! — HE IS WORTHY!". His Beatitude called upon the Sobor participants to await the formal resolution of the Sobor to "officially" proclaim "AXIOS". He presented the qualifications of the Archimandrite and all his accomplishments in the life of our Church and asked him if he would accept such a nomination. Fr. Daniel's response reflected that often spoken in salvation history, "If this be God's Will, then God's Will be done."

His Eminence Metropolitan John and His Eminence Archbishop Yurij, who expressed gratitude for the opportunity to be present at the Sobor and to share in the discussions, which would set the course for the next three years of Church life. Metropolitan John is the Archbishop of Winnipeg and Metropolitan of all Canada and Archbishop Yurij is the Archbishop of Toronto. They were present for the entire Sobor, participating in all general sessions and several of the Sobor committee meetings, offering their thoughts from the perspective of another branch of Ukrainian Orthodoxy.

In presenting his report as President of the Consistory, Archbishop Antony began with comments on the theme of the "Light of Christ" and how that Light has permeated the entire relationship of God with humanity the pinnacle of His Creation. He outlined the evidence of that Light throughout the Old and New Testaments of Scripture and its ultimate manifestation in the Incarnation -God becoming one of us in the Person of Jesus Christ, the Only-begotten Son of the Father and second Person of the Holy Trinity. The Archbishop confirmed, as he always does, that the mission of our Church is the salvation of our souls and proclaimed that mission to all who have questioned him over the past three years about a "mission statement" of our Church, which should appear on our website and in all our official publications.

The Archbishop's report opened with a concentration upon all the accomplishments of the Consistory Offices of Ministry, in particular our Orphanage Adoption Program, All Saints Camp Chapel, the St. Sophia Seminary chapel consecration and

building renovations, the enrollment of 13 seminarians in the 2007-2008 Seminary academic program, the Mission Parish development and Parish rebirth programs and the History and Education Complex construction progress. After expressing his thoughts and concerns about each of these "good things" about which we have much to praise and be proud of, the Archbishop

called upon the Directors of the Consistory Offices of Ministry, whose reports were already included in the Sobor reports packet sent to the delegates in advance of the Sobor. The Archbishop wanted the Sobor participants to be able to put a face to the reports and thus, introduced the Directors, who made necessary additions to their reports and answered questions from the Sobor: Protopresbyter Frank Estocin -Office of External Affairs and Interchurch Relations; Protopresbyter William Diakiw - Office of Publications; Deacon Dr. Ihor Mahlay – Office of Missions and Christian Charity; Natalie

Kapeluck-Nixon — Office of Youth and Young Adult Ministry; Rev. Fr. Harry Linzinbigler — Office of Adult and Family Ministry and interim Director of the Office of Religious Education; Archimandrite Daniel — Office of Public Relations and Communications; Dr. George Krywolap — Office of the Archive and Historical Information; and Dr. Stephen Sivulich — Office of Development.

The Archbishop referred the Sobor to specific items in his report, including the relations with the government and ecclesiastical bodies in Ukraine, the Ecclesiastical-Church Court hearing and ruling in the matter of Holy Ascension Parish, Clifton, NJ, stewardship, the "transitions" in the life of our Church — clergy ordinations, elevations, deaths, the various benevolent gifts to our Church through the last wills and testaments of devoted faithful and his activities as President of the Consistory and the many events he participated in

representing our Church. His Eminence made over 167 parish visitations over the three year period covered in the report - 2004, 2005 and 2006 - for liturgical services and meetings. In concluding his report he listed the staff of the Consistory and the Metropolia Center and thanked them all for their contributions to Church life.

The Director of the Office of Financial Affairs,

Emil Skocypec presented a complete financial report with detailed graphs exhibiting the receipt and utilization of all funds contributed to or earned by our Church. He satisfactorily responded to all questions from the Sobor delegates and forcefully put across the message that our financial condition needs much, much improvement if we hope to continue the multitude of ministry programs we have developed, in addition to maintaining the vast complex, which is our Metropolia Center. Mr. Skocypec was very forthright in stating that our income MUST be increased to avoid continuous operation in the red. The Archbishop has always resolutely proclaimed that "the Lord will provide" and He always has, but we need to be proactive on our own in meeting our problems headon. He expressed his deepest gratitude to the Assistant Director of the Office, Natalia Honcharenko, who has always done a most extensive and accurate job in keeping and reporting our financial affairs.

Ecclesiastic-Church Court presented a report on the Court's hearing concerning the matter of the Church against certain suspended members of the former parish board of administration in Holy Ascension Parish, Clifton, NJ. The Consistory filed a petition of Charges and Accusations with the Court and presented it to the Court hearing. The defendants failed to appear at the hearing and instead sent a letter defying the Court and Church leadership, which was entered into the record. After approximately 45 days of deliberation, the Court ruled



in favor of the Consistory and filed the ruling with the Council of Bishops, as well as informing all involved in the case. The defendants have failed to obey the order and the matter is now back before the civil court for final resolution. Archbishop Antony informed the Sobor that throughout the entire process the courts have ruled in favor of the Church and in the end required the Church

Court hearing, thus fulfilling the obligations of our Church Constitution. There seems to be no reason to believe that the civil court will now reverse previous decisions.

Provost of St. Sophia Seminary rounded out the day's plenary session with his report on the life and activity of the Seminary - in particular concerning the path followed in recruiting our first five seminarians from Ukraine to form the nucleus of the seminary student body. He was delighted to also announce that there are currently nine additional "mature" students participating in the graduate study program of the seminary. These are all men who have completed their undergraduate work in other disciplines, but feel a call to study theology and perhaps seek ordination to the deaconate or the full priesthood. Fr. The Friday evening event of the Sobor was a 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary commemoration of the Genocidal Famine in Ukraine 1932-33. The participants of the Sobor entered the dining room to tables clothed in dark colors, white napkins and spoons. Archbishop Antony invited one individual from each table to come forth to light candles from the one he held and to light the memorial candles on the tables. He then called upon Archimandrite Daniel to read a poetic

work in Ukrainian about the Famine called "Pamyatayemo" (We remember). This reading set the tone for the commemoration. Archbishop Antony then spoke about the Famine in English, proclaiming that WE WILL NEVER FORGET! He stated it was not just the 10 million who starved to death that were lost. Demographers within and without Ukraine have estimated that had the famine not been perpetrated against the Ukrainian nation, the population of Ukraine today would be between 70

and 100 million - rather than 52 million (including those working outside of her borders). This means that in addition to the 10 million, another 28-48 million unborn were lost and with them much of what the nation could have been today. Who knows what great clergymen, scientists, political leaders, educators, artists, writers and others may have changed the course of history for Ukraine? At the conclusion of his remarks, the Archbishop called for dinner to be served – the kind of "dinner" those who perished in the famine may have had...a "soup" made of grass and whatever else could be located to give at least a speck of nutrition and "bread", which sometimes consisted of tree bark. Each individual was served a "bowl" of the soup actually a few spoonfulls - and the Archbishop asked that everyone eat in silence, thinking about what the parents may have been thinking in 1933, unable to provide any more for their children. This "meal" was a very moving experience and the silence was deafening.

Katya offered a very moving description of the conditions of the famine and the long term effects it has had on the nation. Her entire presentation can be found in next edition of the UOW.

Following the remarks, all the participants lit individual candles from the central candle on their table and walked in a silent procession through the darkness and across the footbridge to the Memorial Church for a Panakhyda on the deck before the entrance to the Church. All the

hierarchs in attendance at the Sobor participated in this service, commemorating the innocent souls and victims of the famine - what evil man can inflict upon his fellow man. Metropolitan Constantine spoke before the service reminding the faithful that the very church before which they stood was built as a permanent memorial to the victims of the genocidal famine, who are remembered each time Divine Liturgy is celebrated therein. On Saturday, 6 October, the first item on the agenda was a presentation by the members of the 2007 College Student Mission Team to our Ukrainian orphanages. Adam Kennedy, one of the members and a student of film production at Temple University, created a brief video of the mission experience. It was only six minutes long, but had an enormous effect upon the Sobor audience. A longer documentary version of the video was presented to the Sobor participants on Saturday evening following dinner. presentation and the participants urged the immediate reproduction and distribution to the parishes of these very moving and informative records of our missionary work.

The balance of the day's plenary session was devoted to the presentation of the remaining Sobor Committee reports and their acceptance by the Sobor body, the Youth Sobor Report (a group of high school students, which convened for two days during the Sobor and attended some sessions of the Sobor to learn

The obligation to support St. Sophia Seminary was increased by \$7 to \$12 - \$1 per month! Two new Consistory Offices of Ministry were recommended – the Office of Parish and Mission Development and the Office of Stewardship. The final report of

## 18th Regular Sobor Resolutions

The hierarchs clergy and faithful gathered into the 18th Regular Sobor of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the USA, meeting at the Metropolia Center in South Bound Brook/Somerset, NJ from 4-7 October 2007 and having witnessed to the visible grace of God, which notably marks the vitality of the UOC of the USA resolve:

- That we are ever mindful of the workings of 1. Life-giving Spirit Who is "everywhere present and fills all things". Comprehending the words of His Beatitude Metropolitan Constantine that according to Church Canon Law, the Metropolitan bears responsibility for securing the episcopacy of the Church, we receive, accept and embrace as the manifest will of the Holy Trinity, the nomination by His Beatitude, after consultation with his brother bishops, of the venerable and God-fearing servant of God, the devout priest - Archimandrite Daniel (Zelinskyy) – to the august and most responsible rank and authority of Bishop, successor to the Apostles and witness to the words and deeds of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We are cognizant of Archimandrite Daniel's devoted service to the UOC of the USA, enhanced by his many God-given talents, and we acclaim him by this our solemn proclamation of AXIOS - HE IS WORTHY! We respectfully request that His All-Holiness Bartholomew, the Ecumenical Patriarch of the Great Church of Constantinople, be informed by His Beatitude of our decision so that Archimandrite - Bishop Elect Daniel, may be inscribed into the Diptychs of the Great Church of Christ by the Holy Patriarchal Synod, from whom Ukraine-Rus accepted and embraced the Holy Orthodox Faith and Order 1019 years ago.
- 2. That we are honored to have the blessings of our Archpastors - His Beatitude Metropolitan Constantine, His Eminence Archbishop Antony and His Eminence Archbishop Vsevolod – and profoundly thank them for their continued spiritual and temporal guidance, their labor of love for the good estate of the Holy Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the USA and for their prayers for the sanctification and salvation of her spiritual children. That we respectfully request the Council of Bishops of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the USA to continue the delegation of trusted advisors to intensify a constructive and substantive dialogue with the ecclesiastical jurisdictions in Ukraine, leading to the establishment of one, united, local (pomisna) Ukrainian Orthodox Church.
- 8. That we denounce the 26 June 2007 decision of the Supreme Court of Turkey that affirmed state sponsored religious persecution that if left unchallenged, may represent the juridical justification for the government of Turkey to terminate the existence on Turkish soil of the Spiritual Center of world Orthodoxy - the Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople. The decision criminalizes the term ecumenical, confines the ministry of the Patriarchate to the local Greek Orthodox faithful of Turkey, requires that the members of the synod who elect the Ecumenical Patriarch be Turkish citizens employed in Turkey and that the Ecumenical Patriarch himself be a Turkish citizen. We believe that the court used the judicial opportunity to legitimize the prosecutorial policies of the government of Turkey. We call on the government of Turkey to abandon policies of religious persecution and oppression and to join democratic nations who respect human rights and ensure the dignity of humankind. We call upon the government of the United States of America, the United Nations and the world community to denounce the religious persecution of the government of Turkey and to intercede with all available means to protect the rights of the Ecumenical Patriarchate – the Great Church of Christ.
- 9. That in this the 16<sup>th</sup> year of Ukraine's independence and liberation from that bondage, which marked centuries of Czarist or Soviet oppression, we renew our gratitude to Almighty God for the gift of freedom and assure the president of Ukraine, Viktor Yushchenko and other government leaders of our prayerful support. We call the public servants of Ukraine to labor with love and devotion in securing justice, human rights and equality for all the citizens of Ukraine.
- 10. That we mourn the loss of the ten million Ukrainians who perished during the Artificial Famine and Genocide (Holodomor) in Ukraine in 1921-1933. We demand that the government of the United States of America, the United Nations and the world community officially recognize and proclaim the Artificial Famine as an Act of Genocide. We urge the government in Ukraine to erect a significantly prominent monument in Kyiv that will appropriately commemorate the ten million victims of

We pray for the continued success of these parish families, the eventual attainment of full-fledged parish status for the missions and the establishment, under the guidance of the Holy Sprit, of additional mission parishes and the renewal of inactive parishes.

· Reiterating the words of our father among the Saints, John Chrysostom, "Glory to God for all things!" we greet with enthusiasm and gratitude the inauguration of the 2007-08 academic year at St. Sophia (Holy Wisdom) Ukrainian Orthodox Theological Seminary. Having listened to our pleas, the Lord of the Harvest has blessed our Holy Church's vocation program with 11 students, five from Ukraine in full-time residence and six in the graduate theology program. We pray for the success of their education and the achieve-ment of their vocation. We recognize with much gratitude our Hierarchs, V. Rev. Bazyl Zawierucha, Provost of the Seminary, V. Rev. Stephen Hutnick, Vocations Director, and Archimandrite Daniel, Resident Dean of Student Life for their devoted and extended efforts in developing our Seminary program, which is vital for our future.

- That we lament the intrusion of other Orthodox jurisdictions, both from Ukraine and in the USA, into the life and order of our Holy Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the USA. We demand that the order of Holy Orthodox Canon Law be observed by all hierarchs and clergy of other jurisdictions with regard to our clergy, faithful, parishes and administrative bodies. We find it lamentable that two ecclesiastical bodies comprised of learned men, which both seek world-wide Orthodox recognition, would issue inappropriate and false claims of administrative authority over our Church's clergy and institutions.
- That we prayerfully remember the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary 17. of the 1947 "Aksija Wisla", the forced deportation and resettlement of tens of thousands of ethnic Ukrainians from territories, which were located within the borders of post-WW II Poland, from villages and lands, which for centuries had been inhabited by Ukrainian people. We offer fervent prayers for the repose of those countless souls who perished in local village acts of violence, in the Jaworzhno concentration camp and during inhumane conditions of transportation. May their memory be eternal and may we never forget the suffering of those who survived this ordeal.

- That we applaud the bravery and patriotism of our Armed Forces and intelligence community and pray for them, their families and our country, and for their safe return home. Because our Lord, God, and Savior, Jesus Christ teaches: "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called the sons of God", it is our prayer that the Light of Christ will reveal to all governments the way to end military conflict and bring a lasting peace.
- 26. That we welcome the initiative taken by the Simon Petlura Foundation to renovate the Simon Petlura Library and Archives in Paris, France, and to install a website to enable the entire world to gain access to the works and activities of Otaman Petlura who led the government of Ukraine during the historical period of 1918-21 — Ukraine's short-lived first declaration of independence. 



St. Demetrius Cathedral Carteret, NJ

The founders of St. Demetrius Church (now Cathe- | of St. Demetrius dral) came mainly from central Galicia, today's western Ukraine and south eastern Poland. Without knowledge of the English language or material wealth, but with much devotion and selfdiscipline, these early pioneers founded our parish.

St. Demetrius Church was organized at a meeting of St. Michael's Brotherhood in 1909 and for almost two years its members worshiped in various church buildings around the town. The construction of the church edifice began in 1910 after a parcel of land was obtained on Roosevelt Avenue, and the building was completed in 1911. Unfortunately for almost 21 years, the parish family did not have its own resident priest/pastor. The Pastors of St. Mary's Dormition Church (Father Joseph Chaplynsky and Father Michael Lysiak) of Perth Amboy, traveled to Carteret on a regular basis and ministered to the needs of St. Demetrius until 1930.


From March 1930 until late 1931, the resident priests were Father Anthony Ulanytsky and Father Stephen Sklepkowich who jointly served the St. Demetrius family. In July of 1931, the late Father Joseph A. Zuk became a resident priest who took on all the pastoral duties and faithfully served until September 1932, when, he was consecrated to the episcopacy. The late Archbishop Mark J. Hundiak, then, Father John Hundiak, succeeded him and became its full time pastor and filled that position until 1980, when Fr. Taras Chubenko took over the pastoral reigns of the parish and serves to this day. "Father John" served as pastor

for almost 48 years. During his pastorate, Father Peter Melech became his assistant in August

of 1959 and served our parish as its assistant pastor for 20 years until his untimely death in August of 1979.

Over the years, real estate has been bought and sold by the parish board to accomplish what was necessary for the continued growth of the parish family. Over the past 50 years, various buildings have been built - a pavilion (social club) - Community/ Banquet Center. Various other buildings were bought for future growth and some demolished for the building of a parking lot for the church.

St. Demetrius Cathedral continues to serve the needs of the Carteret Community and our Ukrainian population in Middlesex County. The pastor, Fr. Taras, serves as Chaplain to various departments, including Police, Fire and Office of Emergency Management, as well as many other posts on Community boards. Being an urban environment, the area is undergoing a renaissance and the ethnic composition of Carteret is in constant flux and changing. These changes present many challenges for an Orthodox Community, but we here at St. Demetrius have decided to undertake the challenge for the Glory of God and the good of our Holy Ukrainian Orthodox Church.


